Arizona State Board of Education High School Graduation Requirements for Cohort 2013 and beyond

Four credits of English or English as a Second Language, which shall include but not be limited to the following: grammar, writing, and reading skills, advanced grammar, composition, American literature, advanced composition, research methods and skills and literature.

One-half credit of the English requirement shall include the principles of speech and debate but not be limited to those principles.
